Masters in Management: HEC and ESCP Europe still in the top 10 worldwide

Last year ESCP Europe had created a surprise by finishing first in the world for the quality of his master in management, according to the respected [rankings](#) in the *Financial Times*. I suggest you also read the fascinating comments made over the journalist Della Bradshaw on the [site](#) of the FT. Especially when it notes that among the top 10 institutions listed, only one (Rotterdam) depends on a university.

Again this year, ESCP Europe is an excellent place to ^{3rd} place for its great school master. Always in front CET (for his MSc in Management) but behind the program [CEMS](#) which is also part of HEC. The winner this year is Swiss and is [St. Gallen](#) in a small town an hour speaking Switzerland in Zurich. An environment miles away from big cities who squat on top of the usual classifications does not prevent, for many years, the University of St. Gallen to be one of the best in the world in management.

If the French business schools do not prevail this year, they can still rejoice in their global domination: ranked 11 in the first 30 and 6 in the top 10. Count yourself: ESCP Europe is mentioned, ³ rd, ² nd HEC (with CEMS) and 4th. 5th EM Lyon, ESSEC 8^e (both with their MSc in Management) and Grenoble EM 9^e (with his Masters in International Business).

Only one non-European university fits into the top 10: Indian Institute of Management, Ahmedabad (IIMA), while the WHU - Otto Beisheim School of Management German Vallendar, near Koblenz, makes a grand entrance progressing six places.

While Americans are largely absent from this classification that does not include the MBA, it should come as Asian competition in the future for our European flagship. Four major Asian institutions have in fact established last year what appears to be the beginnings of an Ivy League Asia. The Nanyang Business School in Singapore, the Indian School of Business (ISB) in Hyderabad, the HKUST Business School in Hong Kong and China Europe International Business School (CEIBS) in Shanghai, in fact, working together under the name Asia Top Business Schools ([TABS](#)) to "attract the best students' Europe in Asia."
